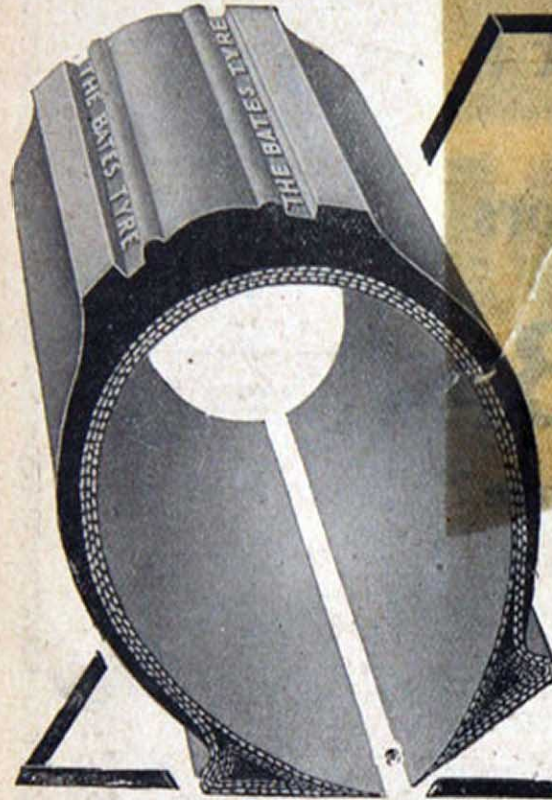


Johannesburg-Durban Race
