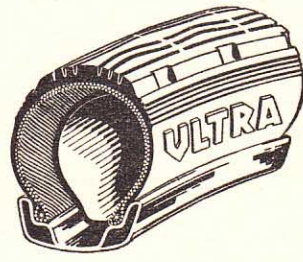

THE BATES ULTRA SPEED TYRE



INTRODUCED in an all-black form at the Cycle Show last year, the low-priced Bates Ultra Speed tyre created a good deal of attention. It has proved to be a really fast tyre with a low power consumption, and possesses, in addition, excellent non-skid properties. The casing, constructed of the finest cotton cord, has a strength usually associated only with the most expensive tyres.

It is made in one size only, 26 x 1 1/4, and is priced at a modest 5s. 6d. for the cover and 1s. 9d. for the tube. There are, of course, two other tyres in the Bates' range, both roadsters: the Wylvorn at 3s. 11d. for the cover and 1s. 6d. for the tube, and the Rambler at 3s. 3d. and 1s. 3d. for the cover and tube respectively.
