the new machine has started.

The Whirlwind bicycle is built with Reynolds 531 tubing and two frame sizes are offered: 21½ in. and 22½ in. Features include Cyclo Benelux Super Sixty five-speed gear, Weinmann brakes, large-flange hubs, high-pressure rims, Michelin high-speed tyres, and racing cut-away saddle.
