



With a sporting performance and perfect road manners, this elegant two-fifty heralds a new era in quarter-litre motorcycles. Here then is a splendid long distance tourer possessing a high cruising speed and an equal measure of comfort, economy and safety.



NEW 249 c.c. TWO-STROKE MOTOR. Unit construction single cylinder engine and 4-speed gearbox. Petroil lubrication (24 to 1 ratio). Deeply finned cylinder and head for efficient cooling. Special 'squish' combustion chamber has projections mating with cut-outs in the piston crown, allowing maximum charge and creating near-perfect turbulence and combustion. Amal Monobloc carburettor in detachable alloy cover with filter and choke. Caged roller big end bearing positively lubricated through grooves in the crankcase to trapoil separated by swirl. Full disc balanced flywheels on \$\frac{1}{8}'' \text{ crankshaft supported by roller bearing on timing side and two ball races on drive side. Wico-Pacy generator for ignition and lighting. Special ignition circuit with emergency position ensures easy starting whether battery is fully charged or flat. Multiplate clutch with Klinger inserts. Four-speed gearbox with foot change, gear indicator and folding K/S pedal.

NEW COMPOSITE FRAME. All the centre frame components, rear swinging fork, etc., are built of steel prespings, the top and engine loop tubes being the only

tubular members in the design. Electical wiring, battery, H.T. coil and rectifier are housed in the centre section and a surrounding platform accommodates the toolkit. Access is provided by two spring-loaded covers. Front and rear suspension have hydraulic damping; the front fork has 5" overall movement and the Girling R/S units allow 4\frac{1}{2}" rear wheel deflection.

LUXURIOUS DETAIL AND FINISH. The rear transmission is totally enclosed in a streamlined chain-case with a hinged cover for access to the rear brake and for chain lubrication. Exhaust noise is reduced to a pleasing note by the special long silencer. AC/DC 6 volt lighting, pre-focussed headlamp, quickly detachable plugs for wiring cables. Special twin bulb tail-lamp with reflector. Foam rubber twinseat. Chromed rims with 6" brakes and 3.25x18 tyres. Deeply valanced mudguards. Protective cover for inflator. Electric horn, toolkit. Choice of martial grey enamel with royal blue tank panels and black seat; or maroon with tropical grey tank panels and seat. Attractive tank badges. Bright parts heavily chromed or cadmium plated.






Foam rubber seat-twinseat available as extra. Smith's speedometer, electric horn, toolkit and pump. Maroon enamel with tropical grey tank panels or martial grey with royal blue panels. All parts rust-proofed.










We do not appoint agents for the sale on our behalf of our motor cycles or other goods, but we assign to motor cycle Dealers areas in which we supply to such Dealers, exclusively for re-sale in such areas. No such Dealer is authorised to transact any business, give any warranty, make any representation or incur any liability on our behalf. Published retail prices are for delivery free of charge at Dealers' premises. All goods are offered for sale subject to the price ruling at the time of delivery. All prices and specifications are subject to alteration without notice.

CONDITIONS OF SALE AND GUARANTEE. We give the following guarantee with our motor cycles, motor cycle combinations and sidecars, including all accessories and component parts other than tyres, saddles, chains and lighting and electrical equipment, and other than accessories and component parts supplied to the order of the Purchaser and differing from those comprised in the standard specifications supplied with our motor cycles, motor cycle combinations and sidecars, but including accessories and parts supplied by way of exchange as hereinafter provided. This guarantee is given in place of any implied conditions or warranties or any liabilities whatsoever statutory or otherwise: no guarantee except that hereinafter contained and no conditions or warranty whatsoever statutory or otherwise is given or is to be implied, nor are we to be under any liability whatsoever except under the guarantee hereinafter contained. Any statement, description, condition or representation contained in any catalogue, advertisement, leaflet or other publication shall not be constructed as enlarging, varying or over-riding anything herein contained. In the case of machines (a) which have been used for "hiring out" purposes or (b) any motor cycle and/or sidecar used for any dirt track, cinder track or grass track racing or competitions (or any competition of any kind within an enclosure for which a charge is made for admission to take part in or view the competition) or (c) machines from which the trademark, name or manufacturing number has been altered or removed or (d) any machines in which parts have been used not supplied by or approved by the motor cycle manufacturer or (e) any machine from which the silencing system as fitted by the manufacturer has been partially or wholly removed or interfered with, no guarantee, condition or warranty of any kind statutory or otherwise, is given or is to be implied, nor are we to be under any liability whatsoever in respect of any such machine. We guarantee, subject to the conditions mentioned below, that all precautions which are usual and reasonable have been taken by us to secure excellence of materials and workmanship, but this guarantee is to extend and be in force for six months only in U.K. and ninety days overseas from date of purchase. or date of exchange in case of any accessory or part supplied by way of exchange as hereinafter provided, and damages for which we make ourselves responsible under this guarantee are limited to the free repair of or supply of a new part or accessory in exchange for the part of the motor cycle, motor cycle combination or sidecar or accessory which may have proved defective. We undertake, subject to the conditions mentioned below, to make good in manner aforesaid any part or accessory covered by this guarantee which has proved defective within the said period. We do not undertake to replace or refix or bear the cost of replacing or refixing any such new part or accessory in the motor cycle, motor cycle combination or sidecar. As motor cycles, motor cycle combinations and sidecars are easily liable to derangement by neglect or misuse, this guarantee does not apply to defects caused by wear and tear, misuse or neglect.

The term "misuse" shall include, amongst others, the following acts:

1. The attaching of a sidecar to a motor cycle in such a manner as to cause damage or calculated to render the latter unsafe when ridden.

2. The use of a motor cycle and sidecar combined, when carrying more persons or a greater weight than that for which the machine was designed by the manufacturer.

3. The attaching of a sidecar to a motor cycle by any form of attachment not provided, supplied or approved by the manufacturers, or to a motor cycle which is not designed for such use.

We do not guarantee tyres, saddles, chains or lighting and electrical equipment, or any accessories or component parts supplied to the order of the Purchaser differing from those comprised in the standard specifications supplied with our motor cycles, motor cycle combinations or sidecars. As regards all such tyres, saddles, chains, lighting and electrical equipment, accessories and component parts, no guarantee, condition or warranty of any kind statutory or otherwise is given or is to be implied, and we are to be under no liability whatsoever in respect thereof.

CONDITIONS OF GUARANTEE. If a defective part or accessory should be found in our motor cycles, motor cycle combinations or sidecars, or in any part or accessory supplied by way of exchange as before provided, it must be sent to us CARRIAGE PAID and accompanied by an intimation from the owner that he desires to have it repaired or exchanged free of charge under our guarantee, and he must also furnish us at the same time with the frame number of the machine, the date of purchase or the date when the alleged defective part or accessory was exchanged as the case may be.

Failing compliance with the above, such articles will lie here at THE RISK OF THE OWNER, and this guarantee and any implied guarantee, warranty or condition shall not be enforceable.

REPAIRS.
