

Lady's Popular Model, P.L., available in four frame sizes

Half-a-million orders received in past eighteen months

Scotland Exports Cycles

CONSTANT demand in all parts of the world is being made for Argyle cycles manufactured by the Glasgow Cycle Co. Ltd., 212-216 St. James' Road, Glasgow. Orders for more than half a million of these machines have been received during the past 18 months, and only the raw material shortage prevents the firm from fulfilling them as speedily as they would like.

At present, four models—two lady's and two gent's—are available to overseas buyers, but as soon as the material situation improves the range will be extended to include several racing and tradesmen's machines.

Of the four available, the Popular models P. (gent's) and P.L. (lady's) are made in frame sizes of 20, 22, 24 and 26in. The smallest frame has 26 × 1\frac{3}{8}in wheels, and the other three, 28 × 1\frac{1}{2}in wheels, with chromium-plated rims and rustless spokes. Brakes are of the roller lever type. Specifications also in-

clude $\frac{1}{2} \times \frac{1}{8}$ in Coventry or Perry chains and Villiers de Luxe ball-bearing freewheels.

All metal is rust-proofed, and finish to the frames and mudguards is heavily enamelled black, with double gold lines. All bright parts are chromium plated.

The Safety Roadsters, models S. (gent's) and S.L. (lady's), are designed to enable riders to support the machines with both feet on the ground without dismounting. Westwood 26 × 13 in wheels are fitted, and frames, of high grade British steel tubing, with low set bottom brackets, are available in 20, 22 and 24in sizes. The lady's model has twin set parallel down tubes. Dunlop Speed tyres, Coventry chains and Villiers de Luxe or Bayliss, Wiley ball-bearing freewheels are provided and handlebars are of the high North Road variety, with two roller-lever brakes. Finish is black enamel, lined with red and gold, with all bright parts heavily chromium plated.

All four models are provided with pumps and clips, tool bags, spanners and oil cans. The Safety Roadsters can be had with a large touring bag as an alternative to the tool bag.
