

TRAINS CHILDREN TO BE "CAR-MINDED"

CHARLES H. PUGH, LTD., makers of Atco motor mowers, have introduced the Atco Iunior Safetyfirst Trainer.

This is a miniature car propelled by a 98 c.c. Atco-Villiers engine, and reproducing the controls of a full sized car, in a form in which children from the age of six can easily master,

The car is for use in gardens, school playgrounds or training grounds under public authorities.

The engine is at the rear, trans-


mission being by chain with one forward speed and reverse. A cone clutch is fitted, and the maximum speed is 8 to 10 m.p.h. There is a brake on the rear axle operated by pedal or lever.

Disc wheels are provided with Dunlop 16 x 21 tyres and the steering column is adjustable for length and
