
## "Now I really know CAREFREE RIDING"

says Mr. R. W. Bobin, Maldon, Essex



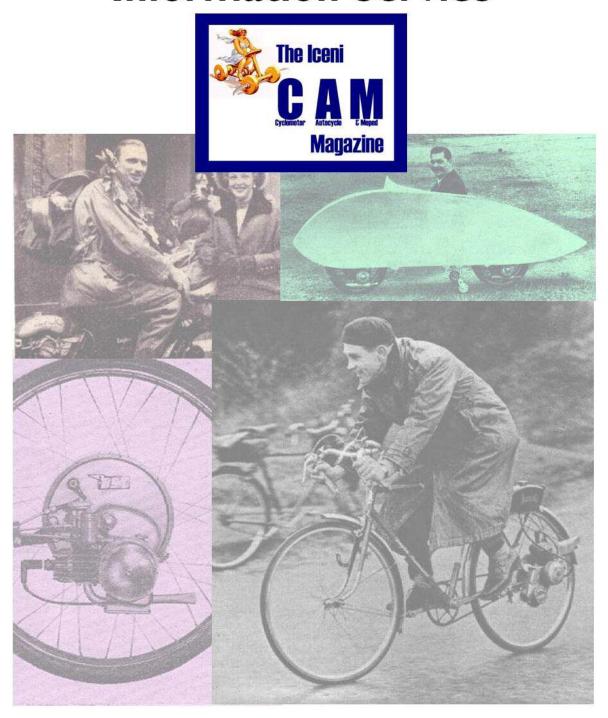
