FOR next year, the Brockhouse Corgi is being continued unchanged. Rigid-chassis and banking sidecarriers are available, as well as conversion kits for fitting a two-speed foot-operated Albion gear box and a Druid telescopic fork. The banking sidecarrier is a Feridax project; and the gear box and fork conversions have been developed by Aston Bros., of Coventry, in conjunction with Albions, Druids and Jack Oldings.

Evolved from the paratroopers' Welbike, the Corgi has a horizontal, 98 c.c.

Spryt two-stroke engine with a compression ratio of 6.9 to 1. The cylinderhead is made of aluminium-alloy. A nickel-chrome molybdenum forging is used for the con-rod. Main bearings are ball journals, and the big-end bearing has alternate steel and bronze rollers. Ignition is by flywheel magneto, which incorporates coils for direct lighting. A single-plate clutch is employed, and the model in standard form is, of course, a single-gear machine. One of the main features of the Corgi is that its handlebars can be folded back and its saddle depressed for storage in a small space.

Made of sheet steel, the Feridax banking sidecarrier, available as an extra, is secured to the machine by a draw bolt which has a quick release pin. The rigid sidecarrier is of Brockhouse design and incorporates an easily removable tray.
