Stand 71: Interesting Autocycles

CHANGED out of all recognition is the Cyc-Auto. Two Superior models and one Carrier model are exhibited. An aluminium-alloy head graces the Scott 98 c.c. engine, which also has two exhaust ports, pipes and silencers. The carburettor is set at the rear.

An open frame is employed, with 1½-gallon petroil tank housed in the frame. Of pressed-steel, the spring fork is a Webb. Mudguards are 3in wide and a substantial rear carrier is fitted.

General Specifications.—Wico-Pacy Genimag Ignition and lighting; Amal carburettors; Dunlop tyres: 26×2×1½in front and rear; fuel capacities (petroll), 1½g.
