

Some outstanding features are.—Easy accessibility for all types of service from small adjustments—to complete dismantling.

Due to position of engine between wheel centres, road shocks and vibration are minimised. The strong carrier provided enables large panniers to be fitted.

The bicycle frame is the result of two years' intensive research to provide maximum comfort with adequate strength and road-

holding qualities.

Twin top tubes are used to give the machine graceful lines. Greater rigidity is obtained by carrying these tubes through to the rear chain stay ends and provides a low riding position. The frame is built of heavy gauge tubing throughout. Heavy dome section mudguards with strengthened stays provide additional rigidity and good weather protection.

"The big factor in the excellent all-round performance of Cyclemate is its useful gearing. The engine is a good puller and the gearing is just right to strike a nice balance between comfortable cruising speed, acceleration and hill climbing."

"Ordinary main road hills could be taken without pedal assistance and it was notice-

able that the engine never seemed to tire or drag."

"At 16/18 m.p.h. the engine could hardly be heard or felt and the comfort of the

machine was fully appreciated. Silencing standards are good and there was little noticeable vibration."

TECHNICAL DETAILS

Engine—2-stroke 32 c.c. Detachable head for easy decarbonising. Compression ratio 6.2 to 1.

The engine has a flat disc valve which controls the gas inlet to crankcase and provides a greater charge per stroke than that obtainable with usual two-stroke design. It gives excellent scavenging and a full cylinder of gas at every stroke. For this reason the 32 c.c. Cyclemaster engine produces as much power as some larger two-stroke engines. The advantages of small cubic capacity are light weight, smoothness and better petrol consumption.

Tank Capacity—5½ pints petroil.

Fitted with a two-level tap so that if fuel runs out there remains a reserve sufficient to run a further 5 or 6 miles to the nearest petrol station.

Drive—Chain with hockey-type guard for weather protection. Overall gear ratio 18 to 1.

Ignition—Flywheel Dynamo with lighting coil.


