CYCLEMATE 1959 DETAIL CHANGES

Two pistol-type chainguards have replaced the earlier patterns on the Cyclemate motorized bicycle, says Cyclemaster Ltd., of Byfleet, Surrey. Additionally, a lighter rear carrier (with spring parcelcip) has been fitted instead of the previous type. Normal brake-levers have taken the place of inverted ones, and the brake-control cables are now outside the handlebars. Britax twist- and dummy-grips are fitted, the front mudguard is shorter, and the front number-plate is now fitted underneath the handlebar expander-bolt.

These changes will apply to all 1959 Cyclemate machines sent out in future.
