

ULTRA-LIGHTWEIGHT motor cycles of 61 and 64 c.c. comprise the Dunkley range. Called Whippet 60, the 61 c.c. machine is a utility model with pressed-steel, spine-type frame of moped appearance while the 64 c.c. Whippet Sports 65, also of pressed steel, has lines reminiscent of the more exotic continental sporting lightweights. sporting lightweights.

Both models employ two-speed over-head-valve engine-gear units of Dunkley manufacture. Cylinder head and barrel are of light alloy and the bore of both engines is 44mm. The larger unit has a longer stroke (42mm as against 40mm) and a higher compression ratio (7.1 to 1 compared with 6.5 to 1).

Telescopic front suspension and pivoted-

fork rear springing are common to both models. Legshields, a windscreen and a luggage carrier are available for the Whippet 60 at extra cost.
