DUNLOP ENDS CYCLE RIM MARKETING

Since Dunlop transferred production of cycle rims to Raleigh, it has been found that the economics of marketing these products, on what is a greatly reduced potential, is no longer justified. It has been decided that (with effect from May 31, 1968) the Dunlop Company Ltd. will cease to market cycle and moped rims.

Dunlop has given advance warning of this intention, so that manufacturers and traders had sufficient time to make other supply arrangements. Dunlop has been advised that Raleigh Industries will deal with any enquiries concerning cycle and moped rims.

Dunlop wishes to make it quite clear that there is no change in the policy for manufacture and distribution of cycle and moped tyres and accessories.
