## Progress

Another busy three months have gone by and there's a lot to report...

### V765

The biggest news must be that we have been accepted by DVLA to handle V765 registration application. We've prepared a couple of information sheets: one for V765 and one for 'Age-related' applications. They're available from the website or write to Andrew for a paper copy.

### Events

We've had our first couple of official runs. The first was the Radar Run on 13<sup>th</sup> April. We haven't featured a 'proper' cyclomotor yet in this column, so here's one. Dave Whatling can be relied upon to bring a cyclomotor to club events and this time he chose his GYS Motamite. This one was built in 1950 and it's a roller-drive unit. Later versions were marketed as the Cairns Mocyc.



This Victoria Vicky 117 was one of the rarer mopeds seen on the Radar Run. It's a 3-speed machine with leading-link front suspension. Maybe its rarity is due to the fact that the 117 was only imported to the UK between June 1963 and October 1964.
