A new approach to moped design by Harry Holt of Ilford allows for alternative engine of 50 or 100 c.c. and in variants of moped or scooter specifications.

Main claim is that it can be made in prefabricated parts and assembled by bolt-up. Folding leg shields and built-in luggage accomodation are featured.
