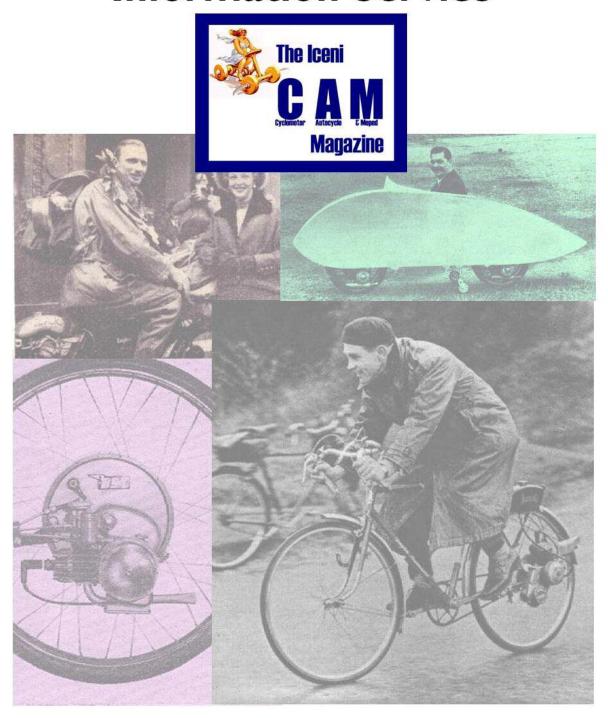


And here's how the new Honda 90 does | it: Engine: single cylinder air-cooled ohv 4-stroke. Bore and stroke: 49 x 46mm. Capacity: 86.7cc. Max. bhp: 6.5 at 8000 rpm. Max.torque: 4.74 ft-lbs at 6000 rpm. Transmission: 4-speed foot-operated constant mesh. Clutch: wet multiplate.
