

With their racy styling and big bike looks there's little doubt that our all-new MBX50 and MTX50 will get you admiring glances. On tarmac or dirt.

But, apart from giving you a reputation for style, both the MBX50 and the MTX50 will give you a reputation that no other bikes can give you: the Honda reputation for advanced technology and legendary reliability.

MBX50S

Restricted by law the 49cc single cylinder two-stroke engine in the MBX50 may be, but the technology that went into it certainly wasn't. That's why it features



efficient, no-maintenance CD Ignition, a five-speed gearbox, expansion chamber style exhaust, even a counterbalancer to smooth out high frequency vibration.

As with the engine, we didn't hold ourselves back with the rest of the MBX50. So we fitted single-shock Pro-Link suspension at the rear for good roadholding and ride comfort, 18" lightweight aluminium Comstar wheels front and back, and a disc front brake with dual-piston caliper. And, like our bigger bikes, we gave it powerful 12 volt electrics.

MTX50S

If you like to look smooth while roughing it then the MTX50 is your kind of bike. Despite legal restrictions on its power output the MTX50, like the MBX50, is packed with big bike looks and big bike features such as Pro-Link single-shock rear suspension developed from our World Championship-winning motocrossers, long-travel 31mm front forks, 49cc single cylinder two-stroke engine with efficient, maintenance-free CD Ignition and a counterbalancer to smooth out high frequency vibration, five-speed gearbox,

bash plate under the engine, and a high level exhaust.

Such carefully designed and thoroughly engineered bikes as the MBX50 and MTX50 deserve a backup service and accessory and clothing range that's just as well thought out and well designed.

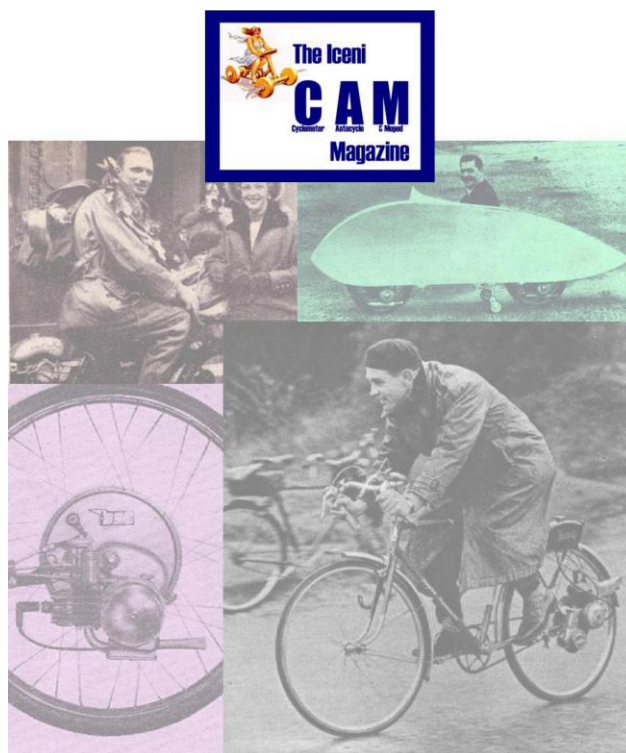
