# Special features exclusive to the Famous James




Illustration No. 1.—The JAMES Head Set illustrated is an exclusive JAMES feature. The Steering Head is an important point in Bicycle construction, which to ensure easy steering should be assembled in perfect alignment. the Ballraces employed in the JAMES Head Set are machined from the solid steel bar, afterwards being hardened and ground.

Illustration No. 2.—The JAMES registered design Oil Bath Gearcase is specially designed for JAMES Bicycles, and its use ensures a well-lubricated chain and efficient protection of the chain from wet, mud and grit. It is rigidly secured to the frame by bolts, which screw into bosses brazed on the frame. No clips are used in its attachment, so that its correct position is always maintained without looseness or rattle. This method of fitting is exclusive to James.

Illustration No. 3.—The JAMES Chain Wheel is another distinctive and exclusive feature of JAMES Bicycles. This is an all steel Wheel of attractive design, which at the same time has the advantage of providing the necessary strength in the directions most required.

Illustration No. 4.—The JAMES solid built Seat Cluster Set is used on all

JAMES Frames, ensuring an all-brazed frame of exceptional strength. This feature has been embodied in JAMES Machines since 1902.

Illustration No. 5.—The JAMES Rim Brakework is fitted to the light roadster models and is a simple yet efficient mechanism, which by reason of its exclusive design is readily detached if it is required to remove the Wheels. The Brake Arches are released by finger pressure on the Spring Arches which releases them from the brazed fittings on the frame and fork. Another exclusive feature is that the Roller Levers are mounted on permanent lugs brazed into the handlebar, which is covered with celluloid to the first brake lug, the other parts being heavily chromium plated.

Illustration No. 6.—The JAMES Patent Stud Hubs as illustrated are obtainable only on certain famous JAMES Models. Their use permits of a straight spoke and limits the bend of the spoke at the head, and provides a direct tangential tension between the Hub and the Rim. This exclusive feature ensures a wheel of extreme rigidity and provides an even tension on each spoke, thus ensuring a true wheel. The bearings are oil retaining and dust proof.



# The Famous James Improved Patent Two-Speed Bracket Gear



THE JAMES IMPROVED PATENT TWO-SPEED BRACKET GEAR increases power and decreases effort. On its normal gear it revolves solid on the bracket axle bearings, and no extra mechanism of any kind is brought into use. The power gear is obtained by a simple epicyclic train being brought into operation through the medium of a small lever attached to the top tube of the bicycle. When the rider desires the low gear a touch of the control lever and the power gear is brought into action, and the rider saves by the operation of this device 25 per cent. of the energy required to overcome the resistance of gradient or head wind. This result is accomplished with a minimum of mechanical loss, as no secondary chain, jockey pulley, additional sprockets or other added impedimenta are employed. The whole gear is self-contained in one unit, and is attached to the bottom bracket spindle by a standard crark cotter.

Illustration No. 1 shows the complete gear as fitted to a bicycle. It will be noticed how neat the device is, adding to the appearance of the bicycle. Illustration No. 2 shows the chain wheel with the planet pinions of the

epicyclic gear in position.

Illustration No. 3 shows the driving pawl which locks together the whole of the mechanism of the gear on the normal or top gear, which, as is well

known, is used for 80 per cent. of the time the bicycle is being ridden.

Illustration No. 4 shows the neat and effective control lever which is fitted. A simple movement backward brings the normal gear into operation,

and the lever is released to the forward position for the low gear.

Illustration No. 5 shows the internal toothed member which is attached

to the driving crank.


From the illustrations it will be apparent how sturdy, strong and simple are the component parts of this gear comparing the proportions of these parts with those which are used in a hub gear, the gear wheels of which are more like the pinion wheels from a clock rather than those which have to transmit the power of an energetic cyclist.

The Bracket Gear revolves at approximately one-third the number of times as compared with the hub gear, with the corresponding reduction of wear and tear, and in no way detracts from the liveliness of the machine.

The JAMES IMPROVED PATENT TWO-SPEED BRACKET GEAR may be used in conjunction with an oil bath or other type of gearcase or chain cover, when its use entails no extra width of tread, and the chain line is in no way affected.

The Gear may be fitted to Tandems and Tricycles with equal efficiency.

# Exclusive features of the Famous James Lightweights



Illustrations Nos. 1 and 2 show the JAMES Compensated Caliper Brakes, which are fitted to the Sports and Lightweight Models described and illustrated. This exclusive design provides an amazingly effective Brake, which adapts itself to any irregularities of the Rim. The operation of the Brakes is light, the slightest pressure on the solid lever being sufficient to provide effective retardation. Illustration No. 2 shows the Brake as fitted to the better models, and Illustration No. 1 shows the Brake as fitted to the Clubman Ace Models and Sports Light Roadsters. On the better models adjustment is provided by an eye bolt and sleeve, which gives a lateral as well as a radial adjustment. On the standard models the Brake Shoe is attached directly to the Fulcrum Lever; adjustment is obtained by altering the angle of the Brake Shoe to this component, but no lateral adjustment is possible.

Illustration No. 3 indicates the Chain Wheel, which is another distinctive feature of the famous IAMES Bicycle. The design is neat and attractive, and provides strength where it is most needed. The Crank fitting is the three-pin detachable type, the function of the bolts being to hold the Crank and Chain Wheel together, all actual drive being taken by bosses formed on the Chain Wheel. There is, therefore, no shearing stress on the attachment bolts.

Illustration No. 4 shows the JAMES Reversible and Adjustable Handlebar Lug, and also the Brake Levers as fitted to the Cable Braked Models. The Handlebar Lug allows the Handlebar to be entirely reversed if required, without risk of damage either to the Clip or the Celluloid Covering. The Levers are particularly neat and comfortable, and provide easy application of the Brakes.

Illustration No. 5 presents a view of the rear fork ends, showing the double sided hub as used on all Road Racing Models. The illustration also shows the triangulated chain stays (registered design) fitted to Road Racing Models as specified. All models are provided with steel fork ends, and particular care has been taken to ensure that they are parallel to each other.


Illustration No. 6 is taken from the rear of the frame and shows the seat stays with the brazed-up seat lug and brazed bridge. The illustration also shows the narrow track of the bicycle, and how the thrust of the chain is provided for by straight chain stay tubes. Both chain and seat stays are tapered tubes of the highest grade material, consequently, every ounce of power the rider puts into the pedals is transmitted to the back wheel.
