



Kreidler

AN attractively styled light scooter, the German Kreidler R50 is priced at just under £100 inclusive of purchase tax. The 49 c.c. engine is fan cooled and is in unit with a two-speed gear box with handlebar control. Material of the cylinder barrel and the cylinder head is light alloy and the barrel has a chromium-plated bore. Bodywork is in pressed steel and the mid-section is hinged to provide access to the engine. Of ample dimensions, the weathershield and footboards give good protection of the rider's legs and feet. A telescopic fork carries the front wheel but the rear wheel is unsprung. Available at extra cost are a pillion seat and pillion footrests, a tribute to the engine's pulling power.
