## LEOPARD MOPEDS

Leopard 2-speed mopeds, of German manufacture, are being imported by Christie and Sadler Ltd., Pluto House, 68 Finsbury Pavement, London, E.C.2. Two models are available in the range—the Bobby 3 and the Bobby 5, both embodying a 50 c.c. Sachs engine. Model 3 has a frame of steel tube, while the de luxe version, Model 5, has a central tubular frame and telescopic rear suspension; trailing link front suspension is also found on this machine. Fuel tank capacity is 8½ pints; 23in. by 2in. wheels are fitted; head lamp incorporates speedometer.


Features of Model 5 include foam rubber saddle, acting also as lid to tool and luggage space; large chainguard; engine encased; pressed steel luggage carrier. Deep valanced mudguards are fitted.

The Bobby 3, equipped with a cantilever rubber-top saddle, has its tool container positioned behind the seat tube.

Another model, is the Bobby 6, which is equipped with a dual seat.
