

Mercury

FROM Wolverhampton come two models which carry the name Mercury. They are the Grey Streak lightweight roadster and the Dolphin scooter. Both are powered by versions of the 98 c.c. Villiers two-speed engine-gear unit.

For the sporting-looking Grey Streak the engine is the Mark 6F with foot gear control; it is housed in a duplex loop frame. A telescopic front fork and pivoted-fork rear springing are featured. Equipment includes a dual-seat.

Long and low, the Dolphin scooter has a fan-cooled Mark 4F power unit. Gear control is by means of a short lever on the handlebar; a cut-out button is also fitted. Features are a large weathershield and a flat
