Simplest

If you want to see just how simple a cycle unit can be, take a look at the new Mark III Mini-Motor. Everything about it has been made as simple as possible. In the first place, it's easily fitted to any cycle, without having to take everything to bits to do so. It's also easy to operate. Everything you want is right there in front of you so you need never take your hands off the handlebar. And, most important of all, it's easy to ride. If you can ride a bicycle, you can learn to Mini-Motor in under 5 minutes. The machine is as simple as that. And, as often happens, the simplest machine is also the . . .

Safest

What do we mean by 'safest'? Simply that the Mini-Motor is fixed to the one part of the machine designed to take the weight of the rider—the saddle tube. That automatically puts it in the place where you expect to carry extra weight—over the back wheel—and in bad weather keeps it out of the way of flying mud and dirt. (By the way, you can easily fit a luggage rack on top of the Mini-Motor.) The drive, is directly on to the back tyre causing the least possible strain on hub, spokes and rim. Simplicity then, makes the Mini-Motor the safest cycle unit you can buy. It also makes it by far the . . .

Cheapest

The new Mini-Motor costs only £18 18s. We're proud of that figure. It isn't a sale price. It's an honest effort to get our product down to a price you can afford without sacrificing reliability or efficiency. In fact the Mark III has new features that make it a better unit even than its predecessors. But we'll deal with them later on.

We have special "Take it Easy" terms which require a down payment of only £2, plus fitting (15s.), tax, insurance, etc., which comes to about £5 10s. The balance is spread over nine months. Your Mini-Motor Dealer will be pleased to give you all the details of the scheme.

Apart from being the cheapest unit to buy, the Mini-Motor is the cheapest to run and maintain. You get more than 200 miles to the gallon with speeds up to 25 m.p.h., and with the new type of roller drive, tyre wear is reduced to a minimum. Service facilities are available throughout this country and in many other parts of the world. Don't be frightened by the word "service.' Everything mechanical needs it some time or another. But the Mini-Motor needs it less than most.

HOW DOES IT DRIVE?

The Mini-Motor fits any bicycle. It has no gears, sprockets or chains. Instead, a special roller, keyed directly on to the crankshaft of the motor, bears straight on to the tyre and rotates the wheel. This roller is made of hardened steel to a new and

special design. It is highly effective in wet weather and gives exceptional tyre mileages.

The drive from the engine to the back wheel is controlled from the handlebar. An entirely new lever enables the engine unit to be raised clear of the tyre or lowered into contact with it. Although this on and off mechanism is very light and easy to operate, it holds the roller very firmly against the tyre. And when the motor is in the 'off' position, there is no extra drag from it when pedalling.

THE ENGINE

The engine is a 49 c.c. 2-stroke-the simplest type of engine in the world. It has a balanced crankshaft running in caged ballbearings of generous size. It is suspended from a chassis which carries the 4-gallon welded steel fuel tank. This rigid chassis is a new and important feature of the Mini-Motor Mark III. The tank is large enough to enable you to buy a reasonable amount of petrol at a time. Oil is mixed with the petrol at each fill-up (there is a measure inside the Mini-Motor petrol cap) and lubrication from then on is automatic. Starting is easy-winter or summer-as we've fitted an engine decompresser which is operated by the throttle control on the handlebar. And, most important, there's power enough in this sturdy little engine to take the leg-weariness out of any hillclimb you may meet.




