

An open side tyre is made for road-racing of 1½ in. section, and is of specially light, flexible fabric. Motor cycle tyres are made of zin., 2½ in., and 2½ in., in both wired and beaded types. All are made extra heavy, of best quality only. A full range of rubber side lines is also shown.
