

## CT20 ICE CREAM TRICYCLE

With the old style 'stop me and buy one' trike, you can now take ice cream direct to the mass public. Ideal for shopping centres, shows and parks, the trike is a very attractive, clean easy to ride machine. Loved by kids and parents, a convenient way of buying ice cream giving a personal friendly service.

- The insulated container with four eutectic inserts gives approx. eight hours selling.
- Two serving hatches give easy access to stock without great loss of temperature.
- The tricycle is approved by councils for wrapped ice cream. This also gives you full stock control when employing staff.
- Various colours, Walls' Lyons maid or to your own specification.
- The CT20 price gives you the chassis as well as the insulated container.
- The insulated container can be taken off the chassis and one of our other boxes can be put on. For example, hot drinks, sandwich / hot drinks, hot dogs and hot chestnuts boxes are available.



### TECHNICAL DATA

#### Insulated Container

Inner container: measuring  $21\frac{3}{4}'' \times 17\frac{1}{2}'' \times 18''$  deep  
 Serving hatches: measuring  $7\frac{1}{2}'' \times 6\frac{1}{2}''$  apertures, 3" insulated lids  
 Insulation: 3" (76mm) thickness expanded polystyrene  
 Plates: four stainless steel flat eutectic inserts each measuring  $15'' \times 9'' \times 1\frac{1}{4}''$ : held in by straps held in vertical position  
 Covering: stove enamelled mild steel panels on hardwood frame with hinged main lid

#### Specification Chassis

Mounting: four rubber mounted bolts hold insulated container in place. These bolts fit into the three other boxes giving you an interchangeable facility.  
 Braking: rim and hub-brakes, latter with parking lock.  
 Carrier: a welded carrier is now a permanent fixture, ideal for strapping a bin to, holding Cokes etc.


- Sandwiches and snack lines can be carried on three shelves, which have easy access from all sides and a lid.

**Water:** Interchangeable tanks. 100+ cup capacity each tank.






# the Pashley CT20 Ice cream tricycle



## Specification CHASSIS

Model No. 33 completely self-contained unit. Mounted on 26" x 2" x 1 $\frac{3}{4}$ " rear and 23 x 200 front pneumatic tyred wheels, with rim and hub brakes, latter with parking lock. Standard finish stove enamelled black. Complete with pump, tool bag, tools etc.

## INSULATED CONTAINER

Stove enamelled mild steel panels on hardwood frame with hinged main container giving easy access to galvanised inner container measuring 21 $\frac{3}{4}$ " x 17 $\frac{1}{2}$ " x 18" deep (552 x 445 x 457mm).

Steel straps fitted to each side of inner container to hold four stainless steel flat eutectic inserts each measuring 15" x 9" x 1 $\frac{1}{4}$ " (381 x 229 x 31mm) in a vertical position.

Main lid secured by two chromium plated lockable catches and fitted with hinged lids to two serving apertures each measuring 7 $\frac{1}{2}$ " x 6 $\frac{1}{2}$ " (190 x 165mm).

Insulated throughout by 3" (76mm) thickness expanded Polystyrene. Finished white enamel. (Other colours to customers specification at extra cost).


