Trojan engine with belt primary drive and belt final. The expanding pulley on the primary drive gives three speeds to the engine. Wipac lighting and Amal carburettor together with 23 x 2in. Dunlop tyres contribute to this all-British machine. In its scooterette form the Joybike is supplied completely enclosed and in the mo-ped form with rear engine cover on near side. This is built a simple machine that can't go wrong". The makers say that all that is required on the subject of servicing is to "leave it alone". Apart from cleaning plug and magneto points occasionally, and oiling cables and chains, no other maintenance is necessary.
