Raleigh "Automatic" MK. II

GREAT sales success with the simple and popularly priced "Runabout" model have led *Raleigh* to introduce an additional machine of the same basic style to be called the RM.8 "Automatic" Mark II, also based on the famous *Motobecane* range of mo-peds.

The new model has telescopic front forks, finned light alloy hub brakes front and rear, better lighting and higher engine power output than the RM.6 and the price is 59 guineas.

Retained in the range for 1964 are the three models already well known, the "Automatic" Mk. I, the spring frame "Supermatic" and the "Runabout". Prices for these remain unchanged.
