**S**UZUKI sales in Britain have already bettered £250,000—mostly in 50 cc bikes. Now, in last week's 800-strong shipment, the sixth Suzuki model makes its debut on the British market.

This model, the 80 cc K11 Sports, will sell for £128 10s, including purchase tax.

Speaking on board SS Chusan—which had brought the consignment from Japan in just over 30 days—Alan Kimber, manager of Suzuki (Great Britain), Ltd, said that more than 3,000 machines had been delivered to their 500 appointed dealers, leaving a substantial volume of orders still to be met.

However, to cater for this increased demand, the December shipment had been increased and was to be supplemented by a Christmas delivery.
