## Blacknell fairing for Tina


Designed exclusively for the Triumph Tina scooter is the new Riviera fairing by Blacknell Motors Ltd., of Arkwright Street, Nottingham. This fairing has been produced to give more protection to the rider than a legshield. Measuring 30in high and 20in wide, it is easily attached by means of six bolts already on a Tina's shield. To give a waterproof joint, the inside edges of the fairing are fitted with rubber beading.

Finished in off-white, giving a pleasing two-tone effect with the lilac of the Tina, the fair-ing weighs 2lbs 6ozs and retails at £5 15s. 0d.
